

Digit Distribution Box Magic

The **Digit Distribution Box** (DDB) arranges digits up in a very special way in a 3 x 3 reference box. If you are a member, log in and read the text that goes with the **Basic Box (DDB)** program for an explanation of how the DDB is set up.

I want to show you something that happened yesterday (September 25, 2014) in the New York Pick 3 game.

NOTE: I like using the box format of numbers. So I turn 350 into 035 and 962 into 269, but it does not matter how you enter them into my programs...you get the same result.

Below is the DDB for the 23rd and I shaded in the digits that hit afterwards on the 24th: 177 and 659. **Notice the empty gap going up the middle: 3-0-8**

Box for September 23, 2014---**177** and **659** hit on the 24th

Below is the box for the 24th.

Notice that **0-7-5** is right in there...**filling in the gap left from the day before!**
750 hit New York in the evening of Thursday September 25.

Box for September 24----**106** and **750** hit on the 25th

How can you use this information?

Strategy: Get yourself a notebook (like I have done) and write out the DDB every night. Shade or circle the digits of the next two numbers that hit on the box and notice the gaps. Look for patterns.

Also, pay attention if most of the digits are from the top (hottest digits) or the bottom (coldest) of the **Digit Distribution Box**.

For example, if you see something like this TWO days in a row (digits from the bottom):

You should expect to see several digits hitting from the top soon after:
