

# The New York FIXED ABC List Is Available NOW!

I made a remarkable discovery on Sunday March 8, 2015. I had just finished working on the Texas tracking program and I started to work on the New York tracking program. For this I used 1010 numbers (which would give me exactly 1000 codes) starting from March 7, 2015 (637, 072) going back to October 19, 2013 (685, 746). This covers a period of 16 months. I entered the numbers onto the **ALPHA Coding System** program to get the codes. After I finished collecting all the codes, I copied them onto the **Group Matching System** and then I divided them into the A, B, and C groups. This time, however, I thought I would try sorting the **actual** 1000 numbers I collected on the **Group Matching System**, just as an interesting experiment. Well, I was quite surprised with the results because I was able to achieve **60%** coverage for the A number with just 80 numbers (I got **62%** coverage with 85 numbers using the codes). **So by using the actual numbers that hit I got pretty similar (or even better) results.**

Then I quickly saw another advantage to using actual numbers; **I can create a FIXED ABC list.** In other words, once I determined what the A, B, and C numbers are based on the last 1000 NY drawings, the three lists would be fixed. This means that I no longer need a program to find out todays or tomorrows A, B, or C numbers: I just need to look at my list. (The list would have to be updated every 3 to 6 months to make sure it's up to date.)

The reason why I am going through this long explanation is because over the weekend I came up with the **Fixed ABC List for New York**. Here are the headlines of each of the 3 lists:

**A Numbers: 76 Singles and 4 Doubles (80)**

**B Numbers: 36 Singles and 24 Doubles (60)**

**C Numbers: 9 Singles and 61 Doubles (70)**

In addition, I created another listing with the SAME ABC numbers – but on this second list they are **arranged by position** with the first number being the hottest (in NY that number is **124**). The last number on the A list (the 80<sup>th</sup> number) is **578**. I did the same for the B and C numbers as you can see below. **So basically what I am giving you here is the EXACT position of ALL 220 Pick 3 numbers for the New York Pick 3 game arranged from hottest (124) to coldest (778)!** (The 10 triples would be in positions 211 to position 220).

## Positional Order

**The Hottest A number is 124 and the coldest is 578**

**The hottest B number is 019 and the coldest is 558**

**The hottest C number is 002 and the coldest is 778**

This is pretty exciting because now you know what the A numbers are **AHEAD OF TIME!**

Also, you do NOT need a program!

**You do NOT need access to my programs: You just need to have the list!**
